Volunteer Activities - March 2016

FRIDAY 11th MARCH -

Forest planning walk - this will be the first of a series of walks around different parts of the 30 hectare site, designed to stimulate and capture YOUR ideas about what you would like to see happening in the forest in future. We'll also be looking out for signs of spring, identifying trees and woodland plants, maybe even spotting a Red Squirrel or two if we are lucky!

1030 to 1300 - bring warm and waterproof clothing plus sturdy footwear (the walk will be largely within the woodland itself - not on roads or footpaths). Tea and coffee will be available at the depot afterwards.



FRIDAY 18th MARCH -

General tidy up and preparation for the Easter event in the old depot area. Clearing scrub, weeding, bonfire (weather dependent), collecting litter, identifying and clearing an area for planting fruit trees.

1030 to 1300 - bring warm and waterproof clothing plus handtools. Tea and coffee will be available at the depot afterwards.
