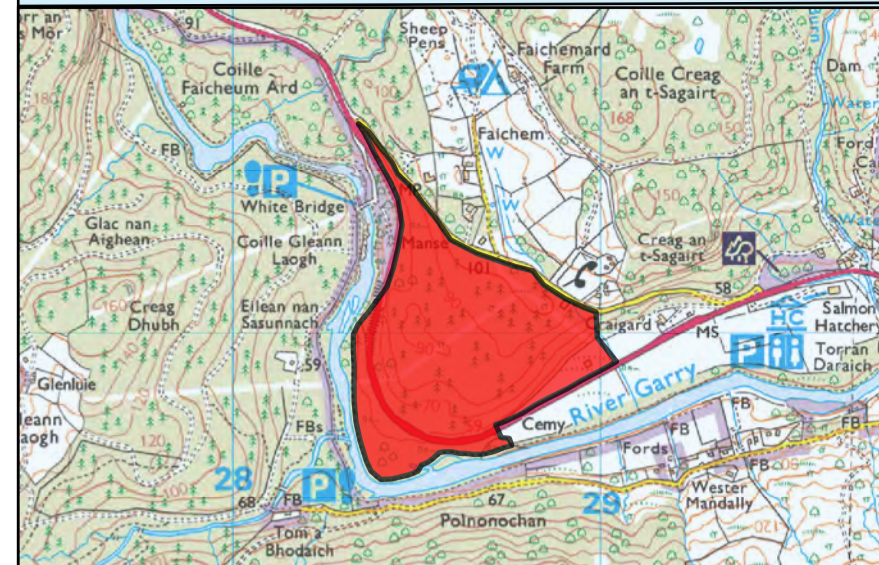


River recreation facilities



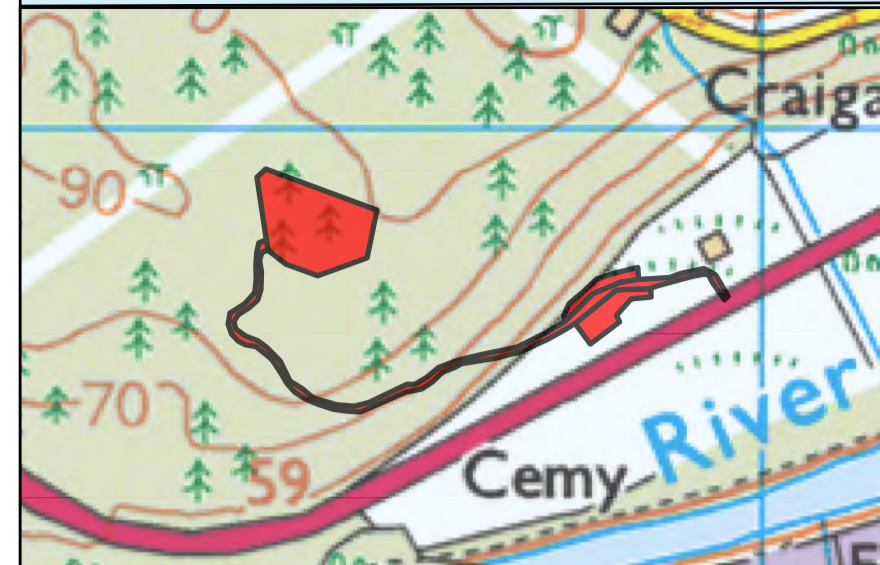
SSE's new bridge at Whitebridge will provide construction access to the Coire Glas pumped hydro scheme, 5 miles to the north west.

Glengarry Community Woodlands



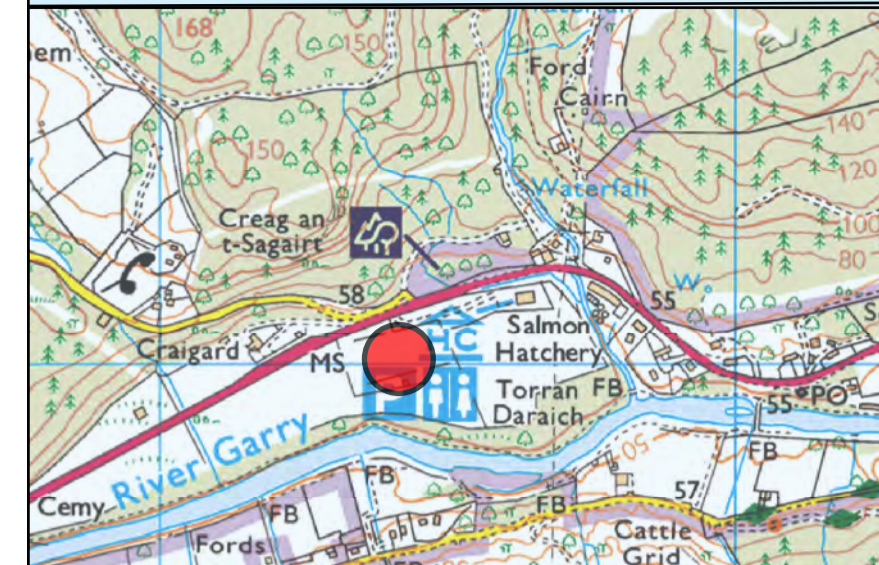
GCW bought this Forest in 2015. It is an Ancient Woodland site, and GCW are managing it for woodfuel, timber, education, and recreation. This could include a path network and entry-level mountain bike trails.

Glengarry Forest Cabins



These 6 forest cabins, owned by the Glengarry Community Benefit Society, will open in early 2025, creating an ecotourism business of forest cabins to provide visitor accommodation right in the heart of Glengarry Community Woodland.

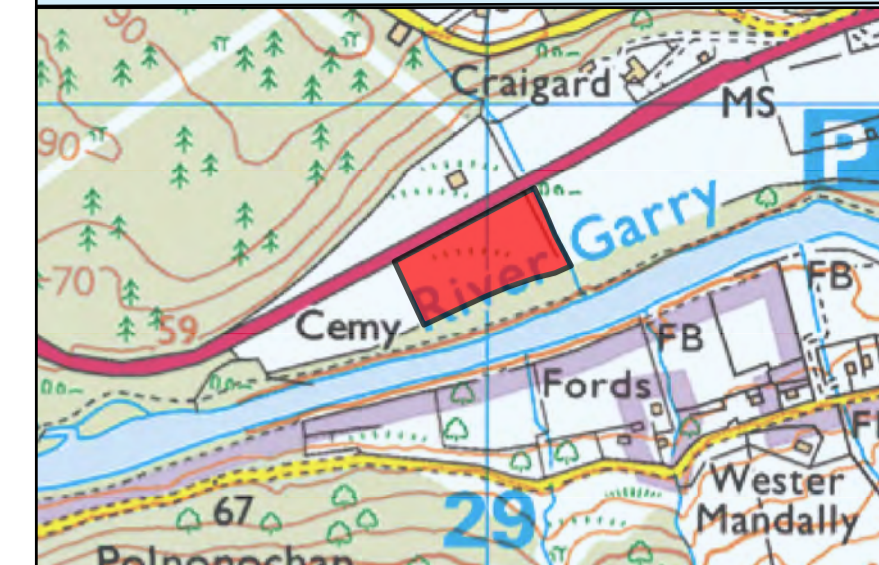
Shinty Pitch and Games Hut



Community assets: Glengarry Shinty Club's Shinty pitch, Pavilion and Equipment shed.

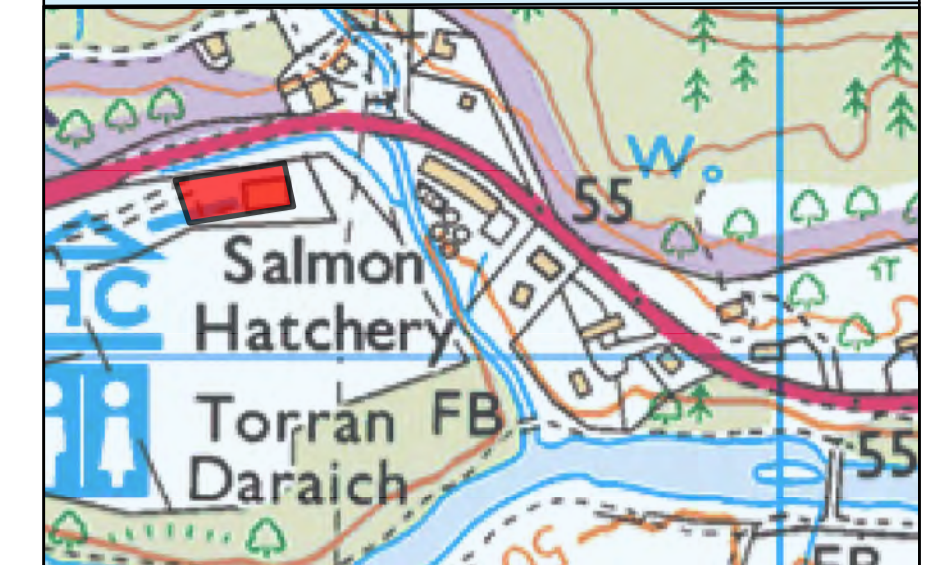
Glengarry Games Highland Association's Games Hut and training area.

Cemetery Field Project

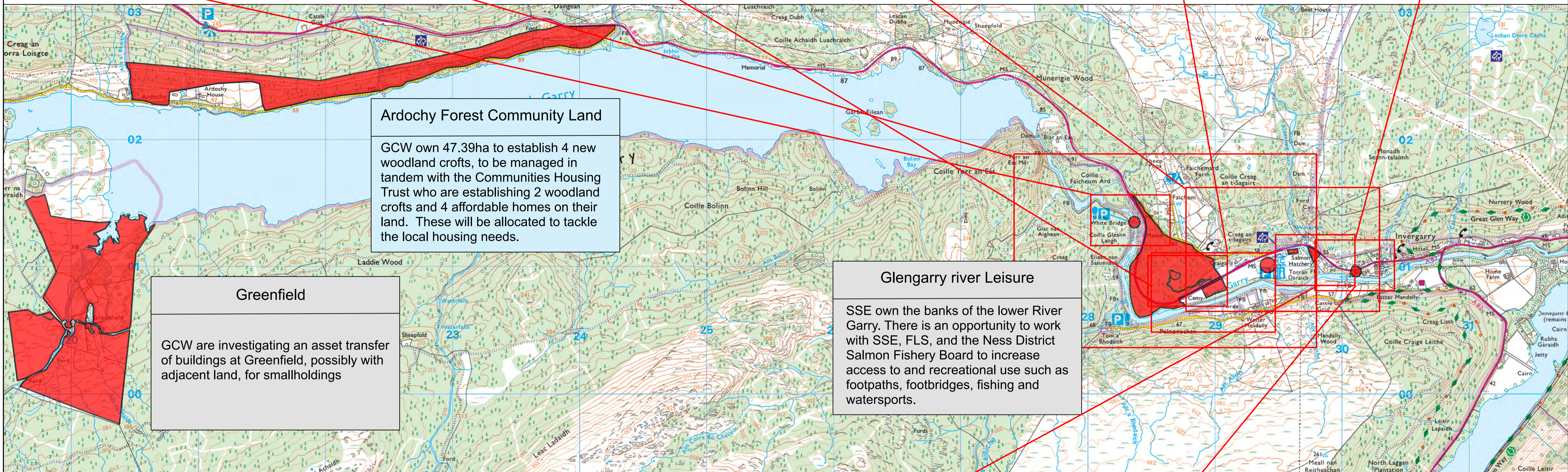


GCW owns this 1.37 ha / 3.4 acre field. The main challenge is that a new vehicular access point to the main road is required; also extension of water, electricity and sewerage. These are significant regulatory hurdles, and costs.

Community Hall



Owned by the Glengarry and District Community Association, the Community Hall hosts activities such as indoor bowls and a Community café; and provides meeting rooms for hire. The Heritage Centre is co-located here.



Ardochy Forest Community Land

GCW own 47.39ha to establish 4 new woodland crofts, to be managed in tandem with the Communities Housing Trust who are establishing 2 woodland crofts and 4 affordable homes on their land. These will be allocated to tackle the local housing needs.

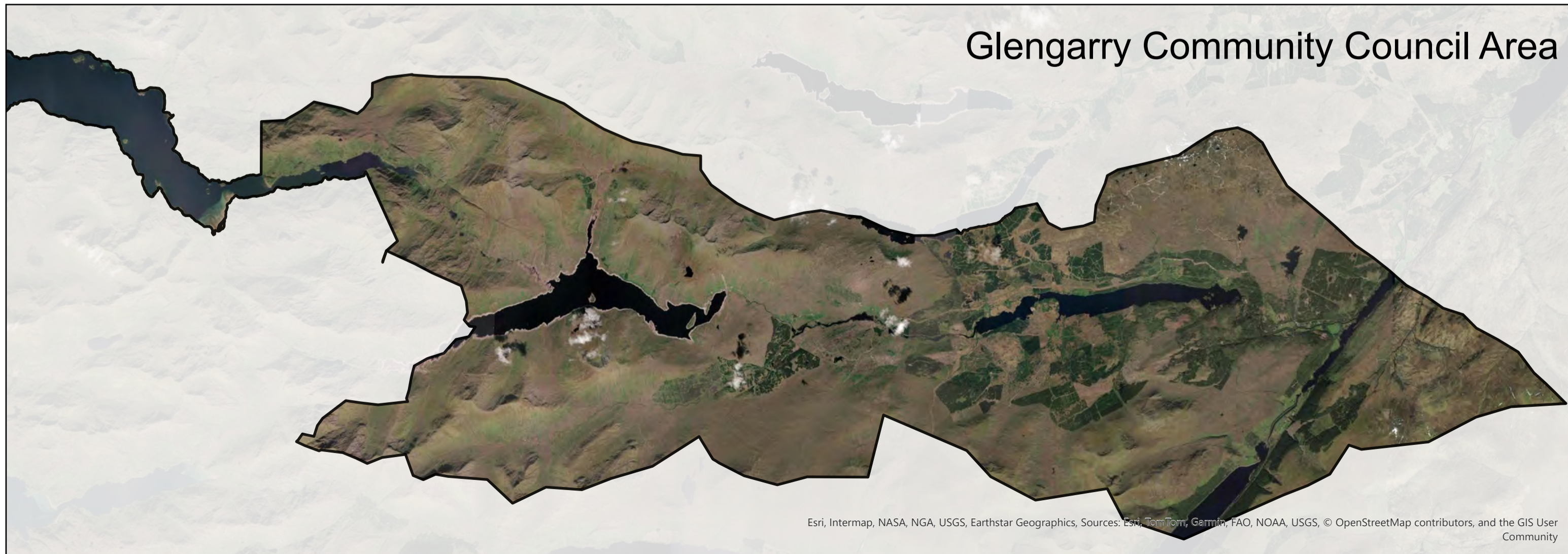
Greenfield

GCW are investigating an asset transfer of buildings at Greenfield, possibly with adjacent land, for smallholdings

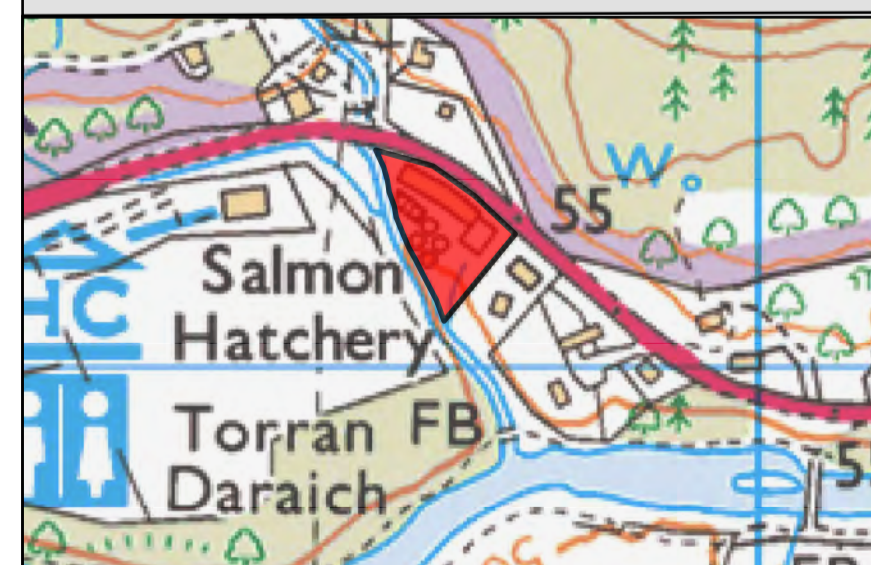
Glengarry river Leisure

Glengarry Community Council Area

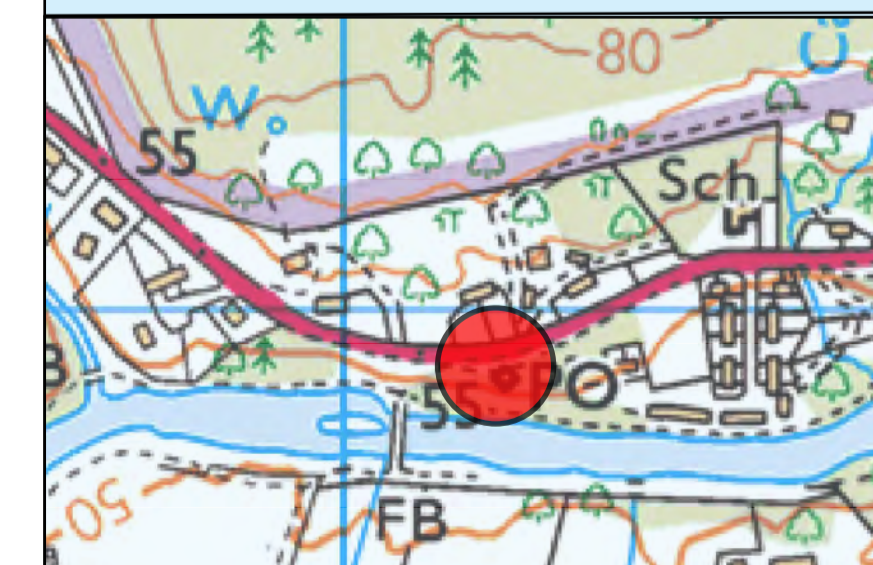


The Old Hatchery



Potential project: SSE would be willing to transfer this site of approximately 0.5 acres to GCW in the next few years, possibly for housing, business units and amenity. Detailed community consultation would be required to agree potential uses.

The Post Office
